

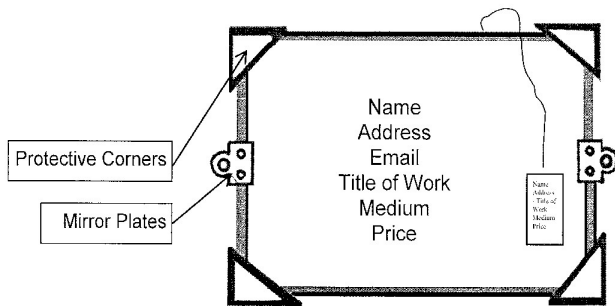
Presentation

All types of Art and craft are welcome (2D and 3D) except installations and performances which cannot be considered due to lack of space.

The title, medium, and price of each work, together with the artist's name, contact details including e-mail, must be shown on a label stuck on the back of the work and also on a tie on label securely attached to the work so that the label hangs visibly over the front of the work.

For all 2D work, frames (if used) should be sturdy and all 2D work should be fitted with two mirror plates half way up each side (see diagram).

No other fixing, string or wires should be attached. Please note: clip frames are not allowed.



3D work needs to fit in the glass display cases provided by The Broomhouse, any queries about size, please contact the gallery staff by email at Chloe.brown@eaststaffsbc.gov.uk

All work should have some protective packing prior to hanging (which is not kept).

All work must follow the above guidelines.

Burton and District Arts Council (BADAC) serves East Staffordshire and its borders with South Derbyshire and Leicestershire.

Entries are welcome from all those who live, work or are educated in East Staffordshire or within a 15 mile radius from the centre of Burton upon Trent.

All work can be priced for sale, please note that the Brewhouse charges 30% commission on sales (which includes VAT) so include this in your price.

Submission

Work must be submitted to The Brewhouse on Friday the 29th April or Saturday 30th April between 10am and 3pm.

Collection of Unselected Work

Unselected work should be collected at The Award Evening or on Saturday 7th May between 10am - 3pm or by arrangement.

All selected artworks will remain on show until the end of the exhibition.

Collection after the exhibition

Selected work can be collected on:
Monday 20th June between 10am and 5pm
Tuesday 21st June 2016 between 10am and 7pm

All work is insured during the exhibition up to a value of £1000
